

Koke'e Civilian Conservation Corps Camp Rates

Per Night Rates Effective February 1, 2020. 2 night minimum. Check-in time is 2pm. Check-out is 11am.

Barracks C

For individuals and families. Included is use of shared Mess Hall facility. ADA access. Single bathroom/shower/coin operated washer & dryer.

Bunkroom (Hostel-Style shared accommodation) 10 beds at **\$30** each.

Semi-Private Rooms (2 single beds per room) 3 rooms at **\$60** each.

Barracks B

Intended for Group Use. Included is use of shared Mess Hall facility.

Two barracks-style rooms with 15 beds and 2 showers/3 toilets in each side. Full barracks allows separation of boys and girls. **\$375** per side/**\$750** for the whole barracks.

Two cabins available. The Mess Hall use does not come with them. There is a bit of a walk to each cabin. Only two parking stalls are available for each cabin.

Executive Cabin (Orchard)

Two-bedroom cabin with kitchen and bathroom, small porch. No living room. Sleeps 4: 1 double bed and 2 singles. Linens included. **\$150**

Foreman's Cabin (Mokihana)

One large room with kitchenette and separate bathroom, large porch. Sleeps 6: 2 queens and 2 singles. Linens included. **\$190**

FULL CAMP: Price to use entire camp is **\$1300** per night (10% discount from rates). This ensures exclusivity. Please work with staff regarding allowed activities at camp. Day use by non-registered guests is not allowed unless signed off by Hui o Laka management. Additional fees may be accessed plus a certificate of insurance. Activities outside the CCC Campgrounds may require a State Parks Permit.

Notes: Hui o Laka members receive a 10% discount off published rates for single rooms or cabins. Only \$100 members and above can rent multiple units or rent the whole camp for a discount. All prices here are for one night with a 2-night minimum. Non-registered guests are NOT allowed without ok from Hui o Laka management. All guests are expected to clean up after themselves. (See cleaning checklist.) Expect to pay a \$250 refundable deposit for mess hall use with groups of more than 8 people. Parking is extremely limited with the expectation that overflow or day parking will be in the lots at Park Headquarters including Lodge, Museum, and Pavilion. Do not block any driveways or park on lawns. All garbage must be removed from camp. Pets are not allowed. All State Parks Administrative Rules are in force. Deposits for 1 night are required to lock-in reservation. Final payment due at check-in.

Only 4 parking stalls are available for barracks stays over weekends. Please advise if you are using vans or buses to deliver groups to the camp. Bunkhouse use requires you to bring your own bedding/sleeping bags. Please check our "What to bring to camp list."
