Hui o Laka has the right to refuse any use of the CCC Camp based on size of group, past misuse, lack of necessary permits/insurance, and appropriateness of activity to the mission of Hui o Laka. Hui o Laka has the right to refuse or cancel any reservation without cause with the return of money collected. Unless you have used the camp before, it is strongly suggested that you make an appointment for a site visit as part of your pre-planning.

Parking is limited. Groups are responsible for plans for busing or offsite parking. State Park Permits may be required for overflow parking. If your planned activities during your stanceds a state park permit, a copy of the permit and a certificate of insurance naming state parks and Hui o Laka must be submitted to Hui o Laka prior to your use. It is your responsibility to adhere to state park rules, specifically those for Koke'e State Park or other state lands your activity encompasses. Keep in mind that it may be necessary to apply for permits 6 weeks or more in advance and that liability insurance may be necessary.
All camp users are responsible for removing and dumping their garbage and recyclable n appropriate facilities outside the state park.
Any damages to property during a stay will need to be acknowledged and made good by camp user. Failure to comply will mean that you will not be allowed to stay at the camp again.
If there are grievous infractions of state park rules or county and state laws by a group using the CCC Camp, the offending party will be evicted and will be banned from using the camp in the future. The party will be responsible for any fines or penalties incurred.
All cleaning protocols, negotiated agreements, and camp rules will be followed by all members of any group. A designated representative will serve as the contact and will speak for and sign documents for a group. They will be responsible for actions of the group during their stay.
